Day 1 :- ARRIVAL TOKYO (NARITA AIRPORT)

- Asakusa – Asakusa retains the vibe of an older Tokyo, with traditional craft shops and street-food stalls along Nakamise Street near the ancient Sensō-ji temple.
- Nakamise Shopping Street – is the most famous shopping street in Asakusa. The street runs for 250 meters on the main approach to Sensoji Temple and is lined on both sides with shops selling traditional souvenirs, snacks, and sweets.
- Uenokoen – is a spacious public park in the Ueno district of Taitō, Tokyo, Japan.
- Ameyayokocho – Ameya-Yokochō, often shortened to Ameyoko, is an open-air market in the Taito Ward of Tokyo, Japan, located next to Ueno Station.
- Akihabara – Akihabara is a buzzing shopping hub famed for its electronics retailers, ranging from tiny stalls to vast department stores like Yodobashi Multimedia Akiba.
- The Imperial Palace – is the main residence of the Emperor of Japan.

Day 2 :- TOKYO – KAMAKURA

- The Buddha at Kamakura – Kotoku-in is a Buddhist temple of the Jodo-shu sect in the city of Kamakura in Kanagawa Prefecture, Japan.
- Tsurugaoka Hachimangu – Tsurugaoka Hachimangū is the most important Shinto shrine in the city of Kamakura, Kanagawa Prefecture, Japan.
- Sea Candle – also known as the Shonan Observatory Lighthouse, is an observation tower and lighthouse located in the Samuel Cocking Garden on the small tidal island of Enoshima in Fujisawa, Kanagawa, Japan.
- Ginza – One of the city's top shopping districts, Ginza is packed with upmarket boutiques and ritzy cocktail and sushi bars.

Day 3 :- TOKYO – MT FUJI - KAWAGUCHIKO - KYOTO

- Mt Fuji 5th Station – The bus will head up to the 5th Station along the Subaru Line. The 5th Station is situated at 2,300meters (7,546 feet) above sea level.
- Oshino Hakkai – are the eight springs found in Oshino, Yamanashi, Japan.
- Lake Kawaguchi – is located in the town of Fujikawaguchiko in southern Yamanashi Prefecture near Mount Fuji, Japan.

Day 4 :- KYOTO

- Kinkaku-ji Temple – Kinkaku-ji, officially named Rokuon-ji, is a Zen Buddhist temple in Kyoto, Japan.
- Tetsugaku No Michi – The Philosopher’s Walk is a pedestrian path that follows a cherry-tree-lined canal in Kyoto, Japan between Ginkaku-ji and Nanzen-ji.
- Hanamikoji Street – One of Kyoto City’s most famous streets, Hanamikoji is situated in the Gion district.
- Fushimi Inari Shrine – is the most important of several thousands of shrines dedicated to Inari, the Shinto god of rice.

Day 5 :- KYOTO – OSAKA

- Casual Tea Ceremony Experience – experience in Osaka typically aims to introduce participants to Japanese tea culture in a relaxed and informal setting, contrasting with the traditional, highly ritualized tea ceremonies.
- ? Sakuranomiya Park – Sprawling city park on the banks of the Osaka River with landscaped greens & cherry blossom trees.
- ? Shinsaibashi – Shinsaibashi is a district in the Chuo-ku ward of Osaka, Japan and the city’s main shopping area.
- ? Dotonbori Shopping Free time – visit the unofficial mascot of Dotonbori is the Glico man. The large neon sign featuring a man running above the Dotonbori bridge.

- Shinsekai – is an old neighborhood located next to south Osaka City’s downtown “Minami” area.
- Tsutenkaku – Owned by Tsutenkaku Kanko Co., Ltd., is a tower and well-known landmark of Osaka, Japan and advertises Hitachi.
