

Tour Itinerary

Day 1:- Arrive Perth

Arrival in Perth Airport (no meet & greet), pick up your rental car at Perth Airport. You can explore Perth city, start with a visit to Kings Park and Botanic Garden for panoramic views of the city and Swan River. Then explore the Perth Cultural Centre, in cluding the Art Gallery of Western Australia. You also can go to Elizabeth Quay, stroll along the riverside and enjoy dinner at own arrangement.

Day 2 :- Perth - Swan Valley - Fremantle - Perth

Begin your day with a visit to Caversham Wildlife Park to get up close with native Australian wildlife, located just a 25?

minute drive from Perth. After exploring, heading to the Swan Valley Food & Wine Trail, a scenic 15-minute drive away. Along the way, you may stop at Sandalford Wines for a tasting and visit The House of Honey and Mondo Nougat & Morish Nuts to sample local treats. Enjoy your lunch in Swan Valley and optional stopping at Mandoon Estate or Margaret River

Chocolate Co. In the afternoon, drive approximately 40 minutes to Fremantle Markets (open Friday-Sunday with free

entry) to browse local crafts and produce. Continue your exploration with a guided tour of Fremantle Prison. On the way back to Perth, stop by the iconic Blue Boat House for a quick photo. Conclude your day with dinner in Perth.

Day 3:- Perth - Busselton - Margaret River

Check-out and start your morning with a scenic drive to Busselton, where you can explore the iconic Busselton Jetty and

visit the Underwater Observatory (optional). Choose to walk the jetty or enjoy a relaxing train ride – both are included in the experience. For lunch, enjoy local flavors at Vasse Bar or Shelter Brewing Co. In the afternoon, continue your journey with a drive to Margaret River. Stop by one of the region's renowned wineries such as Leeuwin Estate or Voyager Estate for a tasting (from \$10 AUD). Then, head to the stunning Mammoth Cave for a self-guided exploration of this ancient limestone formation.

Day 4:- Margaret River - Augusta - Perth

Check-out and begin your morning with a 40-minute drive to Cape Leeuwin Lighthouse, where the Indian and Southern Oceans meet. Entry is included. You can enjoy beautiful ocean views and learn about the lighthouse's history. Then head to Hamelin Bay, where you may spot wild stingrays swimming close to the shore. The best time to see them is in the morning. On your return journey to Perth, enjoy a scenic drive through the majestic Boranup Karri Forest. This peaceful road is lined with tall karri trees and is a great spot for photos or a short nature break. If time allows, make optional stops at Canal Rocks to see the waves crashing through rocky channels, and Yallingup Beach to enjoy the ocean view and fresh sea breeze. It's about a 45-minute drive from Boranup. Wrap up the day with a leisurely 3-hour drive back to Perth. In the evening, enjoy dinner in the city and relax after a full day of exploring.

Day 5 :- Perth - rottnest Island Daty Trip - Perth

In the morning, drive about 30 minutes to Fremantle B-Shed Terminal to catch the Rottnest Express Ferry. The roundtrip

ferry ride is included and takes you across to the beautiful Rottnest Island. Spend the day exploring Rottnest Island at your own pace. You can rent a bicycle for a fun ride around the island or choose the hop-on-hop-off bus for a more relaxed option. Popular spots to visit include The Basin for swimming and snorkeling, Pinky Beach with its scenic coastline, Wadjemup Lighthouse for panoramic views, and Little Salmon Bay for a peaceful beach break. In the afternoon, take

the return ferry back to Fremantle. You may enjoy a seaside dinner at Cicerello's Fremantle, well-known for its delicious

fish and chips before driving back to Perth to end your day.

Day 6 :- Perth - Pinnacles Dessert & Lancelin Sand Dunes - Perth

Start your day with a scenic 2-hour drive from Perth to the unique Pinnacles Desert in Nambung National Park. Wander through the otherworldly limestone formations and enjoy the vast desert landscape, perfect for photos and short walks. After exploring, continue north for about 40 minutes to enjoy lunch in either Cervantes or Jurien Bay, two laid-back coastal towns with fresh seafood and local cafés. In the afternoon, drive about 1 hour to the Lancelin Sand Dunes, a fun spot for

outdoor adventure. You can rent a sandboard for around and try your hand at sliding down the soft white dunes. Wrap up the day with a 1.5-hour drive back to Perth and enjoy dinner in the city to end your adventure.

Day 7:- Perth - Departure

Check out of your accommodation and enjoy some free time at your leisure before heading to the airport. If you'd like to squeeze in some last-minute shopping, consider a 10-minute drive to Watertown Brand Outlet for great deals on fashion and more. After shopping, return your rental car and head to the airport for your departure.
