Chongqing People's Auditorium (???????)- is located at No. 173 Renmin Road, Yuzhong District, Chongqing. Construction began in June 1951 and was completed in April 1954.

- Liziba Viewing Platform (?????????) is located is the first straddle-type monorail in China and the first urban rail transit line in the western region.
- Chongqing Crown Escalator (???????): One of the longest indoor escalators in China and an iconic urban feature of Chongqing. It connects the Lianglukou Metro Station (Lines 1 and 3) with the Caiyuanba Railway Station.
- Eling Park (??????): A park located on Changjiang Road in the Yuzhong District of Chongqing Municipality, People's Republic of China.
- Check-in at Guanyinqiao: 'I Am in Chongqing'"

- Tianxing Town Hot Spring (Bring your own swimsuit) (???????)(????):A renowned hot spring resort located in Tianxing Town, nestled at the foot of Jinfo Mountain in Nanchuan District, Chongqing.

- Jinfo Mountain Scenic Area (Cliff Views & Ancient Buddha Cave)(??????(???????)):A UNESCO World Natural Heritage Site and one of China's top-rated 5A scenic areas. It is renowned for its breathtaking karst landscapes, diverse plant and animal life, and dramatic cliffside views.
- Fairy Mountain Town (???): A charming alpine destination in Wulong District, about 180 km from downtown Chongqing.
   Often dubbed "Little Switzerland of the East", it's a popular summer retreat known for its refreshing climate, lush meadows, and outdoor adventures.

- Tiansheng Three Bridges (Includes Eco Shuttle, Battery Cart, and Sightseeing Elevator) (??????)(????????????): Is a remarkable karst landform in China, characterized by grandeur, uniqueness, danger, beauty, and seclusion.
- Xiannv Fairy Mountain (Includes Mini Train) (???)(????): Situated on the north bank of the Wujiang River and integral to the Wulong Karst World Natural Heritage.

- Jingangbei Ancient Village (?????): A serene, centuries-old village nestled at the foot of Jinyun Mountain, along the Jialing River in Beibei District, Chongqing.

- Enjoy shopping at Jiefangbei Pedestrian Street/Bayi Food Street (????????/?????).
- Proceed to Hongya Cave (???????) night view.
- Qiansimen Bridge (?????): Is a river crossing in Chongqing, China, connecting Yuzhong District and Jiangbei District. It is located on the Jialing River and is part of the secondary trunk road in the northern part of Chongqing.

- Chongqing Mountain City Trail (???????) is a small urban trail that can only be walked. Unlike the small streets and alleys in most cities, the Mountain City Trail has many uphill and downhill steps, which the locals call "staircases".
- The Shibati (???) is located at No. 1 Zhongxing Road, Yuzhong District, Chongqing City. It is adjacent to Jiefang West Road in the south and Zhongxing Road in the north, and is located on the bank of the Yangtze River.
- Huguang Guild Hall (????). A historic cultural complex located in the heart of Yuzhong District, Chongqing. Established in 1759 during the Qing Dynasty, it stands as a testament to the rich history and cultural heritage of the region.
- Ciqikou Ancient Town (?????) is a subdistrict in the Shapingba District of Chongqing Municipality, People's Republic of China
- Chongqing Two Rivers Night Tour (??????)
